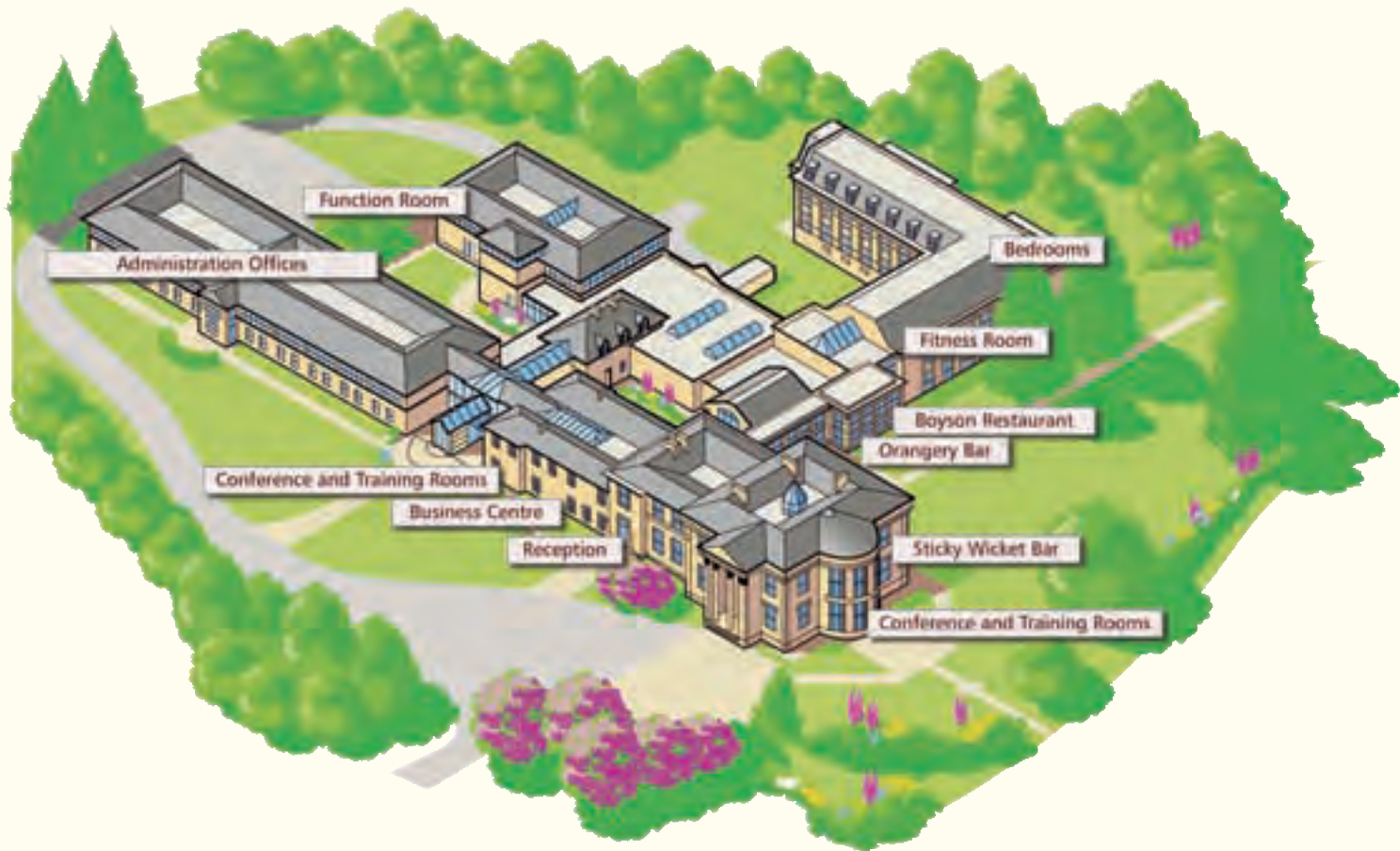

How to find Longhirst



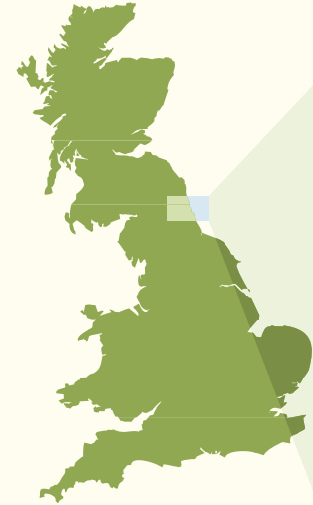
By Car

From the North

Travel down the A1 to approximately 2 miles north of Morpeth. Turn left where it is signposted Hebron - you should also clearly see the sign for Longhirst Hall. Follow the Longhirst signs to the Hall.

From the South

Travel up the A1 and continue north approximately 2 miles past the Morpeth turn off. Keep on the A1 until you see a turning on the right signposted Hebron - you should also clearly see the sign for Longhirst Hall. Follow the Longhirst signs to the Hall.



By Rail and Bus

There are rail and bus stations in Morpeth with a regular service to Newcastle. Pick up can be arranged with Longhirst.

Newcastle International Airport

From the airport, turn left onto the A696, heading towards Newcastle. Joining the A1, head north and follow the map on the right for directions to the Hall.
